

Home Invasion July 12, 2014

OPD Investigators are working a home invasion after receiving a 911 call at 1:06am from a resident on Jasmine Dr. indicating a man had broken into her neighbor's home and attacked her. The victim an elderly female, was punched several times in the face by the intruder but was able to exit the home and run to the neighbor's home, as the intruder moved throughout the home.

Officers responded to the scene but were unable to locate the suspect.

The victim was transported by ambulance to Opel Gen ER. The victim describes her assailant as a tall broad muscular built man, wearing a white scarf over his face, a white button down shirt, dark shades, and a fishing hat. She also indicated he was wearing white gloves. The victim also described her attacker as being athletic due to his ability to move as quickly as he did.

The race of the assailant is uncertain at this time the victim's purse containing several items was stolen.
