

Arrest Lydell Rubin II – April 24, 2014

On Thursday (April 23) morning around 1115am OPD officers responded to a complaint of shots fired in the area of Common and Plaisance Streets. Officers determined that Lydell Rubin II 18 of 817 S Railroad Ave Opelousas fired several shots at Mark Thomas 17 of Baton Rouge La.

The motive for the shooting is unclear at this time.

Thomas indicated he was in Opelousas visiting family members.

Lydell Rubin II was released Feb 14th on a 38,250 bond related to gun possession charges.

At 8:22pm patrol officers along with OPD investigators on foot patrol surrounded a vehicle parked in the very rear of the housing units on Nicole Lane. The vehicle was occupied by several individuals including Lydell Rubin II, Ray Rubin 22 1118 W Cherry St Opel, and John Vidito II 23 of 142 Blake St Opel. Ray Rubin was in possession of a nickel plated 22 caliber revolver, the same weapon described earlier in the shooting on Plaisance St., Vidito had marijuana in his possession.
